- BRIDGES Program: Bereavement, Resources, Infant Loss, Death, Grief, Encouragement, and Support program is used to provide support to our patients who have experienced infant loss. At St. Mary's, we use funds to purchase memory boxes, keepsake items, and supportive materials to help parents cope with their loss.
- **Employee Emergency:** This fund is used to provide emergency financial assistance to CHI Health employees during times of need.
- General Capital/Equipment: This fund is used to purchase, upgrade, or maintain equipment and other items currently needed to support hospital operations, enhance patient care, aid in research, and increase staff productivity.
- Growing Great Kids: This fund supports families as they build healthy, safe environments for their children to grow and learn in, creating a community of compassionate, well-nutured children. This fund provides a one-time well child visit, and home visits to families prenatal to age three.
