Behavioral Services Program: This fund is used to help support inpatient and outpatient behavioral health services for adult and geriatric pateints, and may be used to upgrade equipment, educate our staff, or provide assistance to a behavioral health patient.

Cardiovascular Services: This fund supports our highest-quality, award-winning cardiology programs, and may be used to provide equipment and education, such as heart healthy cooking and daily exercise regimens, to keep our patients healthy.

Clinic General Equipment: This fund is used to purchase, upgrade, or maintain equipment and other items to support hospital operations, enhance patient care, aid in research, and increase staff productivity.

Clinic Patient Assistance: This fund benefits patients treated at CHI Health Clinics by providing assistance for prescription medications, transportation, and other health related needs for patients who qualify.

Emergency Relief: CHI Health Emergency Relief funds provide necessary support to our nurses, physicians, caregivers, and staff, and may be used for caregiver wellbeing, resiliency support, coaching for hospital and clinic staff, medical supplies, food, and other needs.

End of Life Comfort Care: This fund will provide comfort carts that have supportive reading materials, music, and light refreshments for families so they do not have to leave their loved one's bedside.

Faith, Hope, and Love: The purpose of Faith, Hope, and Love is to provide emergency financial assistance to your fellow workers during times of need. Funded exclusively by employee contributions, this fund is administered by CHI Health to current employees who meet the criteria.

Forensic Nurse Examiner Program (FNE): This program seeks to reduce the physical and psychological trauma of sexual assault, human trafficking, and domestic violence through sensitive and timely medical examinations performed by specially trained nurse examiners. Funds are used to educate staff, provide equipment and telehealth capability for examinations, and for community educational outreach. We currently collaborate with the WCA, Project Harmony, and many other organizations to provide care and education to our community.

General Equipment: This fund is used to purchase, upgrade, or maintain equipment and other items to support hospital operations, enhance patient care, aid in research, and increase staff productivity.

General Programs: Funds are used to support programs that are focused on enhancing patient care, staff productivity, and bettering the community we serve, in line with our mission.

General Technology: This fund is used to purchase, upgrade, or maintain hardware and software applications, to aid in patient care, research, and staff productivity.

Infant Bereavement: This fund supplies grief support resources to patients and their families who experience the loss of a baby during pregnancy, at birth, or shortly after firth. Funds are used to purchase memory boxes, keepsake items, semi-annual memorial and committal services, and burial assistance on a limited basis.

Lasting Hope Recovery Center: This fund is used to purchase, upgrade, or maintain equipment and other items to support recovery center operations, enhance patient care, aid in research, and increase staff productivity.

Mental Health Center for Children & Families: This fund will be used to build a new 65,000 square foot facility for children and families that are in crisis. It will have a 24 hour assessment center for all the services, under one roof, and be a center of excellence that brings the latest mental health services to children and families, and give them hope and healing.

Mission Integration: This fund is used to support our mission integration throughout CHI Health, and may be used to support our pastoral care and clinical pastoral education.

Oncology Services: This fund is used to support our oncology departments throughout CHI Health, and may be used to help upgrade equipment, educate our staff, or provide assistance to an oncology patient.

Patient Assistance: This fund benefits patients treated at CHI Health facilities by providing assistance for prescription medications, transportation, and other health related needs for patients who qualify.

Rehabilitation: This fund is used to support our Inpatient and Outpatient Rehabilitation Departments, and may be used to upgrade equipment, educate our staff, or provide assistance to a rehabilitation patient.

Tanzania Ministry - Clinical Officer/PA Program: Funds are used to help with the cost of tuition, room and board. A full scholarship is \$1,700.

Tanzania Ministry - Houses for Health Project: Funds help with the cost of building a small, basic, dry, safe house. The cost to build a house is \$3,400.

Tanzania Ministry - Machame Nursing Scholarships: Funds are used to help with the cost of tuition, room and board. A full scholarship is \$1,700.

Women & Children Services: This fund supports our comprehensive maternity services for moms and babies by providing the most innovative technology and equipment for personalized care.
